As many of you know, Malabar Coal are proposing an underground mine right across the road from Coolmore and Woodlands, the old Drayton South site. It is now known as the Maxwell Underground Coal Mine proposal.

The Independent Planning Commission held a two day hearing last week on this project. I would like to extend my thanks to those that stood up for our industry and our community.

After 10 years, 3 applications, 5 PACs and countless submissions, this is our last chance to impress upon the IPC our concern for mining on this site and the impacts it will have on our industry and our futures. Your views are important and should be heard.
